Pin positions are notoriously clever, transforming routine putts into real challenges.

Many visitors leave determined to return, convinced their next round will master the slopes and breaks. More often, this pursuit becomes a lasting relationship with the club – one that frequently leads to membership.

The appeal of Epsom extends beyond the fairways. The clubhouse, a proud architectural landmark, is both historic and welcoming. Here, camaraderie flourishes, with members enjoying everything from sumptuous, themed dining nights to lively social gatherings that make the clubhouse the heart of the club. It is a place where history, hospitality, and community come together.
